Reservations are on a first come-first served basis. Rental applications must be returned to **The Salvation Army Divisional Headquarters, 103-3833 Henning Drive, Burnaby, BC V5C 6N5** and postmarked after **April 5, 2011**. A deposit of not less than 50% of the total rental fee is required with application. The balance is due on/before **June 10, 2011**.

The Lower Camp Holiday Program is available to Salvationists (soldiers, adherents and regular attendees), their families and friends, Salvation Army employees and other Christians.

All applications must be endorsed by Salvation Army personnel (Officer, Executive Director, Ministry Director) or Church Pastor.

Maximum stay at Camp Sunrise is two weeks. There are no exceptions to this policy.

Cottages:

5 cottages available. Contains kitchenette (with hot-plate and small refrigerator), table/chairs, sofa-bed & bunk bed. Washrooms are located in a separate building. Note: There is an extra charge of \$ for tents on site.

Cancellation Policy

Campers who have booked trailer/tent sites, or cabins may cancel their booking without penalty if Camp Sunrise is able to fill the vacancy. Otherwise, 50% of the rental fee will be charged providing the cancellation occurs prior to two weeks before the occupancy date. Cancellation within two weeks of the occupancy date will result in a 100% charge for the accommodation. Consideration for exceptions will be given for emergency circumstances only. These exceptions will be determined by the Camp Director.

Lower Camp Rules...

Tobacco, alcohol and illegal drugs **are not** permitted on the camp grounds. If an individual has possession and/or is under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs, he/she will be asked to leave the camp grounds immediately. Refunds will not be provided and the camper may be denied rental consideration for future years.

No person who is a minor (under the age of nineteen) is permitted to occupy a tent, cabin or trailer unless under the direct supervision of his/her parent(s) or an adult authorized by the parent (written documentation required). The adult supervisor must also be satisfactory to the camp.

All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas.

Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.

Canoes are to be signed out under the supervision of the Lower Camp Host, Camp Manager or Camp Director. Children under the age of fifteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

The Camp Director or Camp Manager has the right to refuse anyone admission and/or evict anyone who defaults in payment, causes a disturbance, does not comply with camp policy, rules, the law, or who wilfully destroys personal or camp property.

Campfires are permitted only in the approved fire pit and are subject to regional district regulations. An adult must be present at all campfires and the fire must be completely out before leaving the campfire area.

Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Owners are responsible to clean up immediately after their pets.

When a Camp is in session, Upper Camp is considered out-of-bounds to Lower Camp renters.

Camp quiet-time is from 10:00 pm-7:30 am daily.
