



## **Jr. Music & Performing Arts Camp 2010 General Information**

- Ensure you complete and enclose the medical form with application. This form is for the health and safety of your child while at camp.
- Application and payment must be returned to your local Salvation Army Unit. All applications must be endorsed by Salvation Army personnel in order to be processed. Salvation Army Ministry Unit's will forward the application to Divisional Headquarters.
- Travel Arrangements: Campers are to depart from Horseshoe Bay (on July 10<sup>th</sup>) on the 1:35 pm ferry. It is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s) to get their children to Horseshoe Bay and over to Camp Sunrise. **Note: You may want to check with your local Salvation Army Church to see if any arrangements for transportation have been made.** Camp Sunrise staff will be waiting to meet the campers at the Langdale Ferry Terminal and escort them to the camp.
- Campers are permitted to receive mail from family/friends. Address camper mail to: Camp Sunrise (Camper's first & last names), 1377 Burns Road, Gibsons, BC, V0N 1V1.
- To contact a camper in an emergency situation, please call the camp office at (604) 886-7232.
- Camp Sunrise reserves the right to send campers home for inappropriate behavior. The safety and security of our guests is always of highest priority.
- Smoking, drinking, gambling and non-medical use of drugs will not be tolerated on campgrounds.
- Campers are expected to participate in ALL camp activities with the exception of a medical condition.
- Campers are not permitted to leave the campgrounds unless arranged as part of the camp program.
- Spending money for the Tuck Shop (Canteen) **is not** included in the registration fee. If your child brings money, it must be given to the Tuck Shop Coordinator during registration. The Coordinator will keep a tab of the child's spending. Unused money will be returned to your child on the last day of camp.
- Damage or breakage of camp property becomes a personal responsibility.
- All campers will receive a Camp Sunrise T-shirt.

- A final program will take place on Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup> @ 1:30 pm at The Salvation Army Cariboo Hill Temple (7915 Cariboo Road, Burnaby). All campers will be taken by bus from Camp Sunrise to Cariboo Hill Temple. The final program gives family & friends an opportunity to come and enjoy a concert-style gathering, highlighting what campers learned throughout the week.
